half a year has gone – it's time for news from Ordo socialis!

The **extension of the Scientific Council** of Ordo socialis to a global network is for the time being terminated. With Mme. Prof. Gabriel, Vienna, it is now composed of 37 members. 21 members originate from Europe, 8 from Latin-America, 6 from Africa and 2 from Asia. The spokesman of the Scientific Council, Prof. Dr. Markus Vogt, pursues the aim to realize a lively exchange of views between the members of the Council.

From **25th to 27th 2012** an **international congress** will be held in **Brussels** organized by the Konrad-Adenauer-Foundation together with the Catholic Centre of Social Sciences on the subject "**Economic order and social justice in the time of globalization**". Here the members of our Scientific Council, be it as lecturer, be it as invited participant, have the opportunity to make personal acquaintance. The congress will take place in the European Office of the Konrad-Adenauer-Foundation in Brussels.

Following the congress in Brussels our members' meeting in this year will be held on 29th November in the premises of the Chamber of Artisans at Düsseldorf. A special invitation will follow.

The **completion of the website to 5 languages** is terminated. Everyone who likes to visit us under www.ordosocialis.de can immediately choose between 5 languages: German, English, French, Spanish and Portuguese. As we offer besides of these foreign languages also translations in other languages, for instance in Hungarian, Polish and Chinese the page "publications" is international and Anglophone. All existing translations are linked behind the respective title, for instance (French, Spanish, Portuguese,...) The wanted language can be chosen there.

The at the beginning of the year **reshaped German text of the flyer of Ordo socialis** has in the meantime been translated in the four foreign languages of our website. The members of our Scientific Council are asked to use the flyer for publicity of the work of Ordo socialis in their mother-countries.
